It's never too early to start teaching our children how to participate in Holy Mass.

A few tips to help your young child behave and learn about Mass:

- Pray at home daily as a family. This will make parts of Mass familiar to your child – the sign of the cross, the Our Father, etc. even a little one year old can recognize these things when they are a part of life at home.
- Do not bring any toys, activities to church to distract your child that aren't related to Mass, Jesus, or our faith.
- Use children's books about Mass to guide and help them see and understand they are a part of what is going on.
- Give them the opportunity to participate. Teach them to pray quietly, sing, let them put your family offering in the basket, let them know when Jesus is present on the altar in the Holy Eucharist, teach them the sign of peace.

We love our children and want them to feel comfortable and that they belong in God's house. The best way to do that is to let them be a part of what is going on as early as possible instead of distracting them with objects that teach them they do not belong there and have to wait for Mass to be over.
