Dear Parishioners,


In conformity with the wishes of Pope Francis who on July 16 2021 issued *Traditionis Custodes* written *Motu Proprio* (a Latin term meaning "on one's own initiative"), the TLM will cease being celebrated here on a regularly scheduled basis.

After speaking with our Bishop James Checchio, I am encouraged that individuals and the young people who are noticeably attracted to this ancient form of the Mass will be cared for spiritually at the Shrine of the Most Blessed Sacrament in Raritan NJ, under the care of the Oratory of St. Philip Neri, as well as the Blue Army Shrine in Washington, NJ both of which are non-parochial settings, that is, non-parishes as called for by *TC*.

Our bishop has encouraged me to offer the Novus Ordo, the missal of St. Paul VI, ad orientem (facing east) on our high altar which I hope to do starting in Advent on Wednesdays at 6:15pm, and First Saturdays at 12noon. Due to the compliance of the Holy Father, the Sunday TLM Mass at 3pm on Sunday will cease starting the First Sunday of Advent (Nov. 27), as well as the First Friday TLM (Dec. 2) at 7pm. The bishop has assured me and others involved that we may still celebrate the rich heritage of the Extraordinary Form on occasional solemnities and feast days of the liturgical year.

While I know this is a disappointment for some and perhaps an occasion of satisfaction for others not interested in the ancient Mass, we are able to take spiritual comfort in knowing the TLM is still generously available in our diocese in a place that enjoys the flowering of youth and growing vitality of families allowing the richness of this exalted form of Mass to continue to grow organically for the salvation of souls.

It has been a great blessing for me and my own priesthood to learn this ancient Mass which I never experienced growing up which is the common experience of many laity and clergy alike who discover it. For this experience, I am eternally grateful to the Lord and the Church for this treasure.
