INDULGENCES DURING NOVEMBER

An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, may be obtained by those who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. The indulgence is plenary each day from the 1 to 8 of November. On all other days of the year it is partial. A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, may be obtained by those who piously visit a church or public oratory on All Souls Day, November 2nd. On visiting the church or oratory it is required that one Our Father and the Creed be recited. In order to receive these indulgences, you must be free from all attachment to sin, including venial sin, pray for the Holy Father's intentions (see the first page of the bulletin, reception of Holy Communion, and the Sacrament of Penance (Confession). Holy Communion and Penance must be received within seven days.
