Fast and Abstinence

The regulations on Lenten fast and abstinence are: **FASTING:** On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, those who are 18 but not yet 60 are allowed only one full meal. Two smaller meals are allowed as needed but eating sold foods between meals is not permitted. **ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT**: Those who are 14 years of age or older are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
