### Faith Formation Registration School Year 2022-2023

Registrations for Faith Formation will begin the week of May 1<sup>st</sup> for all children in grades 1 thru 8. All children enrolled this year must re-register. If your child/children are entering the first grade in September he/she should be registered at this time. A copy of a Baptismal Certificate is required for registration, unless your child was baptized at Corpus Christi. Application packets will be available in the parish office during regular office hours. As part of a requirement, you should be an active parishioner and attend Mass every week.

### Sunday of Divine Mercy April 24, 2022
