A copy of a Baptismal Certificate is required for registration unless your child was baptized at Corpus Christi. Application packets were distributed in your child's folder at the last class. Applications will also be available at the parish office during regular office hours. As part of a requirement, you should be an active parishioner and attend Mass every Sunday and on Holy Days of Obligation.

An excellent practice recommended by all the saints, especially St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, (1647-1690)

Is devotion to Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament in which through our prayer in silent adoration we make reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus for the sins which have offended God in this world mocking our Savior and His great goodness and love. If possible, for 9 consecutive months attend Mass on First Friday, receiving Holy Communion. If in need of the Sacrament of Penance receive it as well. It has been the time-honored practice as well to make a holy hour before Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist on First Friday of the month which is observed here at the parish church from 3pm-6:45 pm followed by Benediction. All parishioners are invited to offer a minimum of 7 minutes of prayer for the intention of Evangelization, please consider the Lord's merciful invitation to pray and rest in Him, *"I am deeply grieved, even to death, remain here, and stay awake with me (Matt 26:38)."*

St. Margaret Mary has said, *"The divine heart of Jesus is an abyss of all blessings, and into it the poor should always submerge their needs. It is an abyss of joy in which all of us can immerse our sorrows. It is an abyss of lowliness to counteract our foolishness, an abyss of mercy for the wretched, an abyss of love to meet our every need."*

## MARIA EM PENTECOSTES

Como Mãe de cada ser humano, Maria acompanha os discípulos que estavam vacilantes na fé. Diante de tais acontecimentos, com a sua fé já provada, permanece firme. Ela os firma na fé, na ausência física de Jesus após Sua subida aos Céus.

A primeira que acreditou, Maria, junto com os discípulos no cenáculo, encorajava-os a perseverar na oração e numa fé expectante da promessa de Jesus : "Não vos afasteis de Jerusalém. Dentro de poucos dias sereis batizados com o Espírito Santo" (Atos 1,4).

A presença de Maria, em Pentecostes, serve como um testemunho, pois o que a aconteceria com os apóstolos seria o mesmo que já havia acontecido com ela.

No Cenáculo, ela, que na encarnação foi a primeira a experimentar a graça do Espírito, indica que, em Pentecostes, essa graça é a herança de toda a Igreja.

Como nela o Espírito de Deus gerou o Salvador, por Ela se inaugura, em Pentecostes, a manifestação da Igreja.

Uma vez repleta do Espírito Santo, em Pentecostes, Maria permanece com a mesma graça que já havia recebido do Espírito, pois quem está cheio da graça nada mais tem a receber. Maria, porém, com a sua simples presença, é um vaso que comunica a mesma graça que recebera de Deus aos que estavam presentes no cenáculo, como a comunicou a Isabel e a João Batista.

Em Pentecostes, a Igreja foi oficializada, e os discípulos, que estavam amedrontados, tornaram-se corajosos e anunciaram a Boa Nova de Jesus.

O que o Espírito realiza em Maria é o que realizou nos apóstolos em Pentecostes, e é o que realiza, ainda hoje, na vida dos cristãos.
