Confessions are available by appointment or on Saturday afternoon 3:30 to 4:30 p.m, and Wednesdays prior to the mass 5-5:45. Confessions will be heard in front of the grotto (weather permitting) or in the church hall vestibule.

Dispensation from Obligation

The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass will remain in effect until further notice. No one will be required to attend Mass during this period of time. While the obligation to attend Mass is dispensed, the faithful are to keep the Lord's Day holy by some other means. For example, they should tune into a live streamed Mass, and can also be encouraged to pray the Liturgy of the Hours, reading and reflecting on Sacred Scripture, praying the rosary or some other devotion.

Parents are asked to choose a weekend Mass in August, (excluding the weekend of August 29/30.) The Masses available are Saturday: 5pm, & Sunday 10am, 11:30 (Portuguese), and 5pm, for your child to receive the Sacrament.

You MUST register you child for the Mass you choose. There is a limit of 6 children per Mass to receive their First Holy Communion.

New Jersey Safe Haven Law – Under the New Jersey Safe Haven Infant Protection Act a person may give up an unwanted infant anonymously. The purpose of Safe Haven is to protect unwanted babies from being hurt or killed from unsafe abandonment. A distressed parent who is unable to care for an infant can give up custody of a baby less than 30 days old safely, legally and anonymously. All that is required is that the baby be brought to any hospital emergency room, police stations, fire station, ambulance, first aid, and rescue squads in New Jersey that are staffed 24 hours a day, seven days a week. As long as the child shows no signs of intentional abuse, no name or other information is required. The parent can call the Safe Haven Hotline – 1-877-8392339 – and get the address and directions for any hospital emergency room, police station, fire station, ambulance, first aid, and rescue squad in the state.
