Returning to Masses with a Congregation Those in vulnerable groups should stay home. Those who are sick or symptomatic must stay home.

Exit through all doors after Mass. NO ENTRY ON SIDE DOORS. The church has been sanitized and will be cleaned after each Mass.

Confessions are available by appointment or on Saturday afternoon 3:30 to 4:30 p.m. and Wednesdays prior to the mass 5-5:45. Confessions will be heard in front of the grotto (weather permitting) or in the church hall vestibule.

Dispensation from Obligation

The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass will remain in effect until further notice. No one will be required to attend Mass during this period of time. While the obligation to attend Mass is dispensed, the faithful are to keep the Lord's Day holy by some other means. For example, they should tune into a live streamed Mass, and can also be encouraged to pray the Liturgy of the Hours, reading and reflecting on Sacred Scripture, praying the rosary or some other devotion.

Due to the Covid 19 restrictions, First Holy Communion will take place in small groups.

Parents are asked to choose a weekend Mass in August, (excluding the weekend of August 29/30.) The Masses available are Saturday: 5pm, & Sunday 10am, 11:30 (Portuguese), and 5pm, for your child to receive the Sacrament.



You MUST register you child for the Mass you choose. There is a limit of 6 children per Mass to receive their First Holy Communion.
