- Story Time

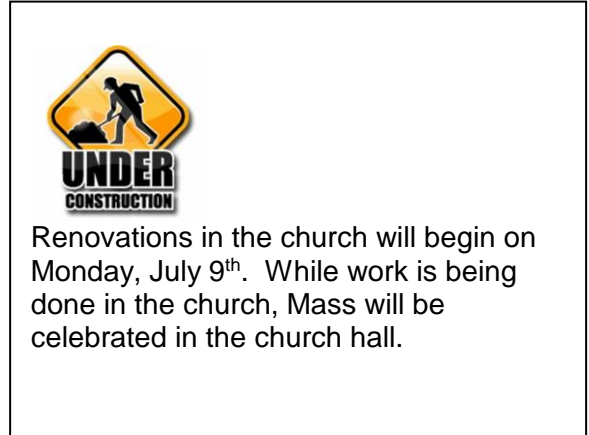
Everyone participating will be entered on a raffle for the opportunity to receive one of three \$10 certificates to the Milltown Ice Cream Depot.
