**Returning to Masses with a Congregation**  
Those in vulnerable groups should stay home. Those who are sick or symptomatic must stay home. Wash hands at home and use hand sanitizer prior to entering the church. Face masks are expected by all except for the very young. The faithful will be expected to bring their own hand sanitizer for their family. Always maintain physical/social distance of 6 feet. Congregation will enter through the front door only. Exit through all doors after Mass. NO ENTRY ON SIDE DOORS. The church has been sanitized and will be cleaned after each Mass.

### Dispensation from Obligation

The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass will remain in effect until further notice. No one will be required to attend Mass during this period of time. While the obligation to attend Mass is dispensed, the faithful are to keep the Lord's Day holy by some other means. For example, they should tune into a live streamed Mass, and can also be encouraged to pray the Liturgy of the Hours, reading and reflecting on Sacred Scripture, praying the rosary or some other devotion.
