Faith Formation Registration School Year 2022-2023

Registrations for Faith Formation has closed. All children enrolled this year should be registered at this time. As part of a requirement, you should be an active parishioner and attend Mass every week.

Ad Hoc Committee

Parish Registration

All parishioners should be registered. Parishioners over the age of 18 should register independently of their parents. It is necessary to be a registered parishioner for at least 3 months in order for us to provide testimonial letters. Kindly notify the Parish Office of any changes in address, phone number.

OCD or RMD

Are you 70 ½ or older? Have you lost the ability to fully deduct charitable contributions because you no longer itemize federal income tax deductions? Do you make donations to Corpus Christi Church regularly? If you answered yes to these questions, you may want to consider making a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). A QCD is generally a non-taxable distribution made directly by the trustee of your IRA to Corpus Christi or other qualified charities. A QCD reduces your Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) and thereby reduces taxes. If you are receiving a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) from your IRA, a QCD can be used to help satisfy the RMD. Please consult your tax advisor or tax return preparer to determine if a QCD could benefit you.
