That grief is always with us because we never stop loving the one we lost. However, grief does change as we learn to use our inner strengths to heal. The group offers support to help with the feelings of isolation, sadness, loneliness, and grief in an atmosphere that is safe and reassuring, so each person can remember, reverence and honor their loved ones while learning to live their own lives to the fullest potential possible.
