Raise the Roof and Make a Sound in Christ Campaign 2022

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This past weekend I announced to the parish faithful that the roof remediation has begun and is progressing in good time in which we anticipate all repairs will be concluded by the first week of August of this year. Such an undertaking has been extraordinarily expensive and has constrained us to spend from our reserves in the parish management fund with the diocese (our account from the sale of the school) upwards of \$315,668.00. Additionally, we were also required by the Diocese of Metuchen to pay off our entire debt we owed in back assessment which totaled \$146,000.00 in addition to \$47,000.00 that was already paid this past fiscal year ending in June 30, 2022. Your contribution will be non-assessed, restricted income and will benefit the parish exclusively in this hardship.

While we are still waiting to learn if the insurance will cover any or a portion of these costs, I have decided to inaugurate a capital campaign to bolster our ability to recoup this major expense in the hope that we will have monies to paint the church interior (i.e.,ceiling repair once the remediation is finished and interior wall) and proceed with the purchase of a new organ, as the existing organ has outlived its life-span and parts for its repair are no longer at hand.

In this major financial undertaking, I have named this campaign, placing it under the patronage of good St. Joseph *"Raise the Roof and Make a Sound in Christ."* If any parishioner would like to join our efforts in fundraising, please contact me at your earliest convenience.

Also, as I announced, parishioners who have already donated to our boiler fund, their restricted donation may be applied to their pledge. The pledge card is intended to invite your additional participation if you choose to donate again, but most of all to ask for your spiritual sacrifice and your prayerful support to this campaign's undertaking and success.

To foster this spiritual intention, I ask everyone to pray daily the Memorare to St. Joseph for the fruitful and providential help of God to us at this time, for unless we seek the help of Heaven, our human efforts alone achieve very little, without God's assistance and grace, our works in themselves remain lame and ineffective, without our constant reliance upon God for all things big and small, are works are devoid of faith and rendered less without the supernatural strength that comes from God alone: "Unless the Lord builds the house, in vain do its laborers labor (Psalm 127:1)."

May St. Paul's words ring in our hearts and echo in our service: *"Whenever we have the opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith* (Gal 6:10)"
