Dispensation from Obligation

SECOND COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND 2020 Missionary Cooperation Plan

Fr. John Kariuki from the Diocese of Ngong in Kenya was scheduled to visit Corpus Christi next weekend and offer the Annual Mission Appeal, however, in light of the current travel restrictions due to Covid-19 pandemic he cannot travel. He has asked that we supply the parish with as much information on the Diocese of Ngong as we can on his behalf.

The Theme of the 2020 Missionary Cooperation Plan is strengthening of the small Christian communities. In the Diocese of Ngong Small Christian communities play a major role in the work of evangelization. The small Christian community is the church of the neighborhood. Once the members of the small Christian communities are well trained, they will be able to steer the church to be self-reliant, self-supporting, and self-evangelizing.

The diocese has thirty-six parishes. They will bring the leaders of the small Christian communities together in deanery level in our five deaneries, in three years, two trainings every year for five days each. The trainings will be conducted by priests from each deanery who are well versed with the matters small Christian communities.

The Catholic Diocese of Ngong history dates back to 1913 when a diocese was established to serve the spiritual needs of the Maasai pastoralist community. In 1976, the prefecture of Ngong became a diocese and Bishop Colin Davies became its first bishop. In 2009, Bishop Davies retired on health issues and was succeeded by Bishop John Oballa Owaa, who was named Bishop in 2012.

The main economic activity is nomadic pastoralists, wheat farming and tourism. The area has high illiteracy levels and most of the people living in the area hold strongly to their traditional cultural values. Poverty and apathy have grown wide and resulted in the area of lagging behind in general development and Christianity. The area has poor infrastructure network, thus aggravating the situation.

The theme of the appeal is to use the proceeds to strengthen Small Christian Communities in their parishes since they play a major role in the work of evangelization. They will train churches in the neighborhood so that they will be able to steer the church to be self-reliant, self-supporting and self-evangelizing.
