"If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all." MARK 9:35

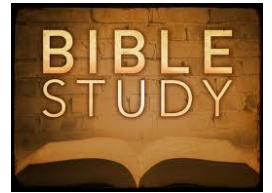
