Sacred Relics of the Saints: Treasures of the Church


Immaculate Conception Parish (Spotswood) presents a teaching and exposition of Sacred Relics on **Monday, September 20 at 6:30 pm.** Father Carlos Martins of the Companions of the Cross will be there with an extraordinary Vatican collection of over 150 relics some as old as 2000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Joseph, St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the Little Flower), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. There will also be a portion of the Veil of Our Lady and one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. Throughout history, many healings have been worked in the presence of relics; and thousands have occurred through this ministry. Do not miss this opportunity. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members, which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession.

"The Evangelization Ministry would like to give a special thanks to all the volunteers and families who participated in this year's VBS program. We had a great time as the Children learned about Jesus and how they can make a difference in the lives of those impacted by the water crisis. The total money raised for the
