Returning to Masses with a Congregation

Please note: The **8:30 am Mass** is now officially changed to **8am** throughout the year.

Confessions are available by appointment or on Saturday afternoon 3:30 to 4:30 p.m. and Wednesdays prior to the mass 5-5:45. Confessions will be heard in front of the grotto (weather permitting) or in the church hall vestibule.

Dispensation from Obligation

The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass will remain in effect until further notice. No one will be required to attend Mass during this period of time. While the obligation to attend Mass is dispensed, the faithful are to keep the Lord's Day holy by some other means. For example, they should tune into a live streamed Mass, and can also be encouraged to pray the Liturgy of the Hours, reading and reflecting on Sacred Scripture, praying the rosary or some other devotion.

Faith Formation Registration 2020-2021- If you have not yet signed up your child/children, pick up a copy of the form at the exits of the church and return as soon as possible to the parish office. Deadline was August 30th.

First Communicants – If you have not yet returned your Communion Register Sheet this must be done or your name will not be entered in the Sacramental Register that you received the Sacrament. If you have any questions, call the parish office and leave a detailed message, your call will be returned.

BEREAVEMENT A Journey of Growth and Healing Surviving a Loss

Grief is a process that takes time, but ultimately leads us to heal from the pain of the loss of a loved one: a spouse, a parent, a child, a sibling or a friend. That grief is always with us because we never stop loving the one we lost. However, grief does change as we learn to use our inner strengths to heal. Our mission is to allow individuals to become more aware of their inner gifts and strengths. Kathy Ostertag will come from a therapeutic stand while Sr. Kathleen will incorporate prayer and spirituality into the process. Our group offers support to help with the feelings of isolation, sadness, loneliness, and grief in an atmosphere that is safe and reassuring, so each person can remember, reverence and honor their loved ones while learning to live their own lives to the fullest potential possible.

Kathleen Ostertag, a licensed therapist, and I began our bereavement program at Corpus Christi last year. Because of COVID-19, we have been unable to continue with that program in person. However, we are working on beginning again in September, and will run the group for 6-8 weeks by way of ZOOM (Even if you do not have a computer we will try to work something out.) Grief is God's gift to help us to heal physically, emotionally, and spiritually. We hope you will allow us to accompany you along your healing journey.
