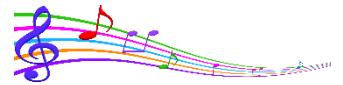

Music Ministry Notes

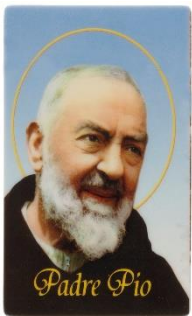
