An excellent practice recommended by all the saints, especially St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, (1647-1690)

Is devotion to Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament in which through our prayer in silent adoration we make reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus for the sins which have offended God in this world mocking our Savior and His great goodness and love. If possible, for 9 consecutive months attend Mass on First Friday, receiving Holy Communion. If in need of the Sacrament of Penance receive it as well. It has been the time-honored practice as well to make a holy hour before Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist on First Friday of the month which is observed here at the parish church from 3pm-6:45 pm followed by Benediction, All parishioners are invited to offer a minimum of 7 minutes of prayer for the intention of Evangelization, please consider the Lord's merciful invitation to pray and rest in Him, "*I am deeply grieved, even to death, remain here, and stay awake with me (Matt 26:38).*"

St. Margaret Mary has said, "*The divine heart of Jesus is an abyss of all blessings, and into it the poor should always submerge their needs. It is an abyss of joy in which all of us can immerse our sorrows. SOLENIIDADE DE CRISTO REI DO UNIVERSO

Celebramos, hoje, o último domingo do Ano Litúrgico, chamado Solenidade de Nosso Senhor Jesus Cristo, Rei do Universo. Esta meta foi-nos indicada no I Domingo do Advento e, hoje, a atingimos. Visto que o Ano Litúrgico representa a nossa vida em miniatura, esta experiência primeiro nos ensina e, depois, nos recorda, que estamos a caminho ao encontro com Jesus, o Esposo, que virá como Rei e Senhor da vida e da história. Referimo-nos à sua segunda vinda: a primeira, quando veio como um humilde Menino, depositado na manjedoura (Lc 2, 7); a segunda, quando retornará na sua glória, no final dos tempos. No entanto, há outra vinda intermediária, que vivemos, hoje, na qual Jesus se apresenta a nós com a Graça dos seus Sacramentos e na pessoa de cada um dos "pequeninos" do Evangelho - "Em verdade vos declaro: se não vos tornardes como criancinhas, não entrareis no Reino dos Céus"... (Mt 18,2), isto é, somos convidados a reconhecer Jesus na pessoa dos nossos irmãos e irmãs, a negociar os talentos recebidos, a assumir nossas responsabilidades todos os dias. – Ao longo deste caminho, a liturgia se oferece a nós como escola de vida para educar-nos a reconhecer o Senhor, presente na vida cotidiana, e preparar-nos para a sua última vinda.

Não haverá Missa em Português nesta terça-feira dia 28 de Novembro, 2023 por motivo da Missão paroquial. A intenção da Missa foi mudada para sexta-feira dia 1 de Dezembro, 2023.
