## **Semana Nacional de Conscientização Vocacional**

Esta semana de 3-8 de Novembro celebramos a  
Semana Nacional de Conscientização  
Vocacional, uma celebração anual de uma  
semana dedicada a promover as vocações ao  
sacerdócio, à vida consagrada e ao casamento  
através da oração e da educação. Pedimos que  
rezem pelos nossos seminaristas e irmãos em  
formação e pelos casais em preparação para o  
casamento na nossa paróquia.

## **POR QUE REZAR PELOS MORTOS?**

É certo rezar pelos mortos. O livro dos Macabeus ordena a  
oração pelos mortos, dizendo: "É um santo e salutar  
pensamento este de orar pelos mortos" (Cf 2Mc 12,42-45).  
Judas Macabeu, acreditando no perdão de Deus e na  
ressurreição, quis que se rezasse pela salvação daqueles que  
morreram. Há pessoas não-Católicas que infelizmente, por  
ignorância, não aceitam o Segundo Livro dos Macabeus como  
parte integrante da Bíblia. Mas mesmo essas pessoas não  
podem negar que os hebreus daquele tempo, séc. II antes de  
Cristo, tinham firme convicção de que era boa coisa rezar  
pelos falecidos. A mesma convicção esteve entre os primeiros  
cristãos e permanece, entre nós até hoje. Isso nos mostra que  
podemos e devemos oferecer missas e orar por aqueles que  
já se foram. Vejam bem, nós não entramos em contato com  
os mortos, pedimos a Jesus por eles.

As inscrições nas catacumbas, cemitérios cristãos dos  
primeiros séculos, incluem votos para que os defuntos  
encontrem repouso e "refrigério" (= consolação). Desde os  
primeiros tempos, a Igreja honrou a memória dos defuntos e  
ofereceu preces em seu favor, principalmente missas,  
recomendando, também, esmolas, indulgências e obras de  
penitência em favor deles. Honramos a memória dos defuntos  
e condenamos a necromancia (invocação, consulta aos  
mortos), que é proibida claramente, pela Palavra de Deus (Cf  
Dt 18,9-14). É esse um dos modos de viver o belo dogma da  
"Comunhão dos Santos", verdade de fé que a gente lembra  
todas as vezes que reza a Profissão de Fé, o Credo.

O nome "Comunhão" lembra "comum união, união de todos".  
Por essa comum união, há um intercâmbio de preces,  
sufrágios e dons entre os que militam na terra, Igreja Militante,  
os que aguardam juízo e estão sendo purificados, Igreja  
Padecente, e os que já foram admitidos na glória celeste,  
Igreja Triunfante. Neste admirável intercâmbio, cada um se  
beneficia da santidade dos outros, bem para além do prejuízo  
que o pecado de um possa ter causado aos outros. Assim, o  
recurso à Comunhão dos Santos permite ao pecador ser  
purificado mais cedo e mais eficazmente das penas do  
pecado.

Reza-se nas ocasiões de exéquias (honras fúnebres), de  
enterro, sétimo dia, agradecendo a Deus pela vida da pessoa  
falecida cuja fé, oração, trabalho e dedicação, educação  
religiosa deixaram em nós as marcas de um verdadeiro  
testemunho Cristão. Reza-se, também, pedindo a Deus que a  
pessoa falecida, tendo perdoadas as suas culpas entre o mais  
brevemente possível, ainda que passando pela purificação do  
purgatório, na posse do Reino dos Céus.
