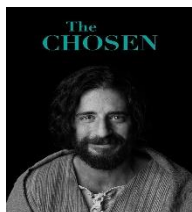

2024 Lenten Obligations

1. The days of both fast and abstinence are Ash Wednesday (February 14) and Good Friday (March 29).
2. The other Fridays of Lent (Feb 16, 23 & Mar.1, 8, 15, & 22 are days of abstinence.
3. Fasting in Roman Catholic tradition means to limit oneself to one full meal with two smaller meals which together do not equal the size of your full meal.

The Obligation of fasting applies only to Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59.

4. Abstinence in the Roman Catholic tradition means to abstain from eating meat (beef, chicken, pork, turkey, etc.). The obligation of abstinence applies to all Catholics who have reached the age of 14.

Note: This year be aware that Ash Wednesday falls on February 14 (also Valentine's Day). The obligation to fast does remain in effect, so it is suggested that those who are planning a special dinner make that their one main meal of the day.

OBRIGAÇÕES DA QUARESMA 2024

1. Os dias de jejum e abstinência são a Quarta-feira de Cinzas (14 de fevereiro) e a Sexta-feira Santa (29 de março).
2. As demais sextas-feiras da Quaresma (16 e 23 de fevereiro, 1, 8, 15 e 22 de março) são dias de abstinência.
3. **Jejuar** na tradição católica romana significa limitar-se a uma refeição completa com refeições menores que juntas não equivalem ao tamanho da sua refeição completa. A obrigação de destino aplica-se apenas aos católicos com idades entre 18 e 59 anos.
4. **Abstinência** na tradição católica romana significa abster-se de comer carne (bovina, frango, porco, peru, etc.). A obrigação de abstinência aplica-se a todos os católicos que tenham atingido a idade de 14 anos.

Nota: Este ano, esteja ciente de que a Quarta-feira de Cinzas cai em 14 de fevereiro (também Dia dos Namorados). A obrigação de jejuar permanece em vigor, por isso sugere-se que aqueles que estão planejando um jantar especial façam dessa a refeição principal do dia.
