If mom had been responsive, she would have said how much she loved it and would have thanked the person for bringing it to her. That simple act of placing a handmade lap blanket on a dying patient means so much to those who receive such kindness. Knowing that someone outside our little family took time to make a beautiful item with intention fills our hearts with joy. Thank you for reminding us that there are still people who care about others.”

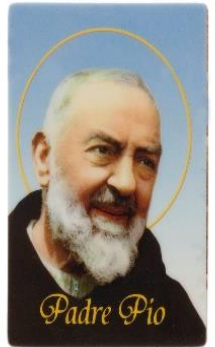
