Corpus Christi Parish Finance Council
Report to The Parishioners
2021 -2022 Fiscal Year.

The Parish Finance Council has prepared this report and accompanying narrative to provide you with some information about the financial status of Corpus Christi for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022.

Please spend a little time reviewing this information so that you might be better aware of the financial operations of our Parish.

There are 644 registered households and 1,932 registered Catholics in our parish, down about 17% from 2 years ago. Of these 25%, or so, are inactive.

The 2022 Financial Report finds us in a deficit situation for the fiscal year. Expenses exceeded income by about \$33,500.

Overall revenue increased over \$154,000 from last year.

Expenditures also increased significantly, up \$280,000. This was in large part due to the necessity to replace the boilers in the church and major repairs to the interior support system of the roof.

Due to these extraordinary expenses, we were forced to withdraw almost \$600,000 from our savings in the diocesan Investment Management Fund. In addition to the repairs, this allowed us to pay off our outstanding balance for the diocesan assessment (\$146,000). These funds are to be utilized for the final ceiling roof work to start in Mid-January (adhering the sheet rock to the support beams and then spackling and painting), the refurbishment and insulation of the church windows, a new organ, and eventually the painting of the church interior.

At the close of the fiscal year, we have approximately \$745,600 in the diocesan fund and almost \$43,000 in the Sacristy fund. This fund, sourced by directed gifts from parishioners, is for specific improvements such as the Organ, and Raise the Roof Campaign, or other specified intentions

Please pray that God may continue to bless Corpus Christi, as He has in the past. We don't know God's plan for our parish, we must rely on our faith. We must remember God's plan for us is not our plan. God's plan for us is far larger and better than any plan we can imagine.

Thank you for your time, attention and ongoing support. If you have not already done so, please consider a pledge to our *Raise the Roof & Make A Sound In Christ* campaign, that will be used to offset the cost of our major repairs.

If you have any questions or would like additional information, please seek out either Father Damian or any member of the Finance Council. We welcome your feedback, input and ideas. May God continue to bless us all.
